

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for www.NJAGC.org

This privacy policy applies solely to information collected by this web site. It will notify you of the following:

- What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the web site, how it is used and with whom it may be shared.
- What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
- How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to/collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us, including membership status, conference presentation acceptance status, event registration, sponsorships, donations and book sales. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request.

Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via email in the future to tell you about things such as NJAGC events, information related to Gifted Children, providing on-line and print publications, or changes to this privacy policy.

We use Google Analytics to understand whether our online presence is effective. In order to analyze site traffic and other information related to the use of our website, we use cookies to collect relevant data. Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

All on-line payments made directly through the NJAGC web site are processed through [PayPal](#), a third-party, on-line payment system. Payments made directly through our office are processed via the PayPal

virtual terminal. Event payments are processed through [Constant Contact](#). Financial data is not saved in any of these instances by NJAGC nor does NJAGC has access to the credit card information provided by the user to these companies. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon at the bottom of your web browser, or looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the web page.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees or Board of Trustee members who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, membership renewal or Conference presenter confirmations) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.
